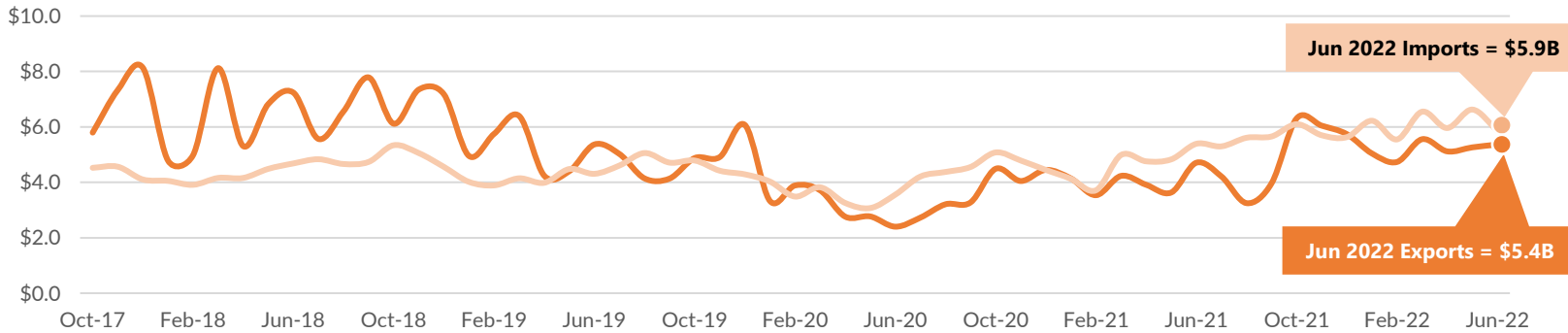


In the second quarter of 2022:

- **Exports Tick Up:** Businesses in WA exported \$16 billion worth of goods in Q2—slightly higher (+3%) than in Q1 2022 and a 28% increase compared to Q2 2021.
- **Imports Sidewind:** Goods imports totaled \$18 billion in Q2—roughly equal to Q1 2022 and 23% higher than in Q2 of 2021. Canada, China, and Japan remain the top import origins.
- **Steady Trade Volume:** The WA port system transported around \$47 billion in goods—2% more than the prior quarter (Q1) and a 7% increase compared to Q2 of 2021.

Total Monthly Goods Exports & Imports

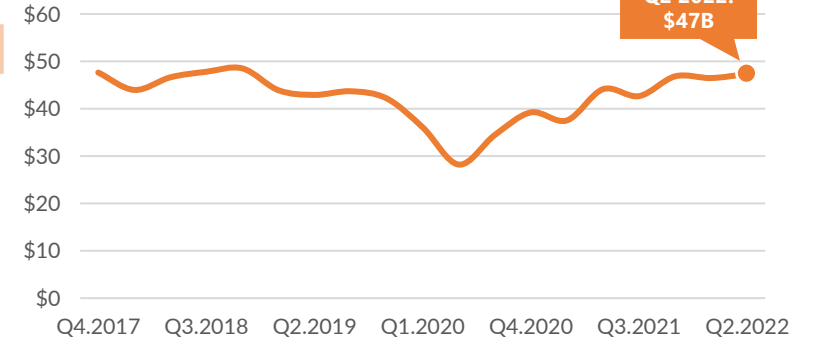
Billion \$; Oct 2017 – Jun 2022

1,000s of jobs; As of 2020

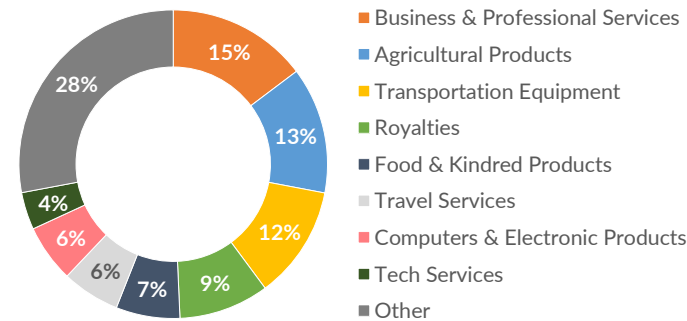
Total Jobs Supported by Exports = 243k
